HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

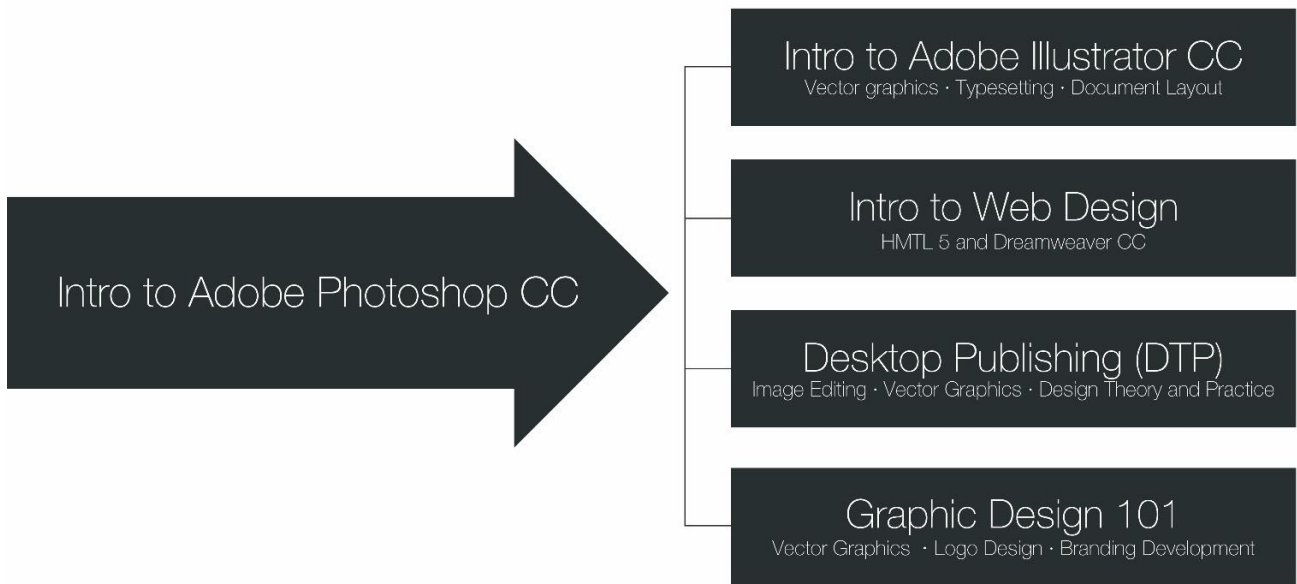
